A Walk in the Woods – Storytelling package

Lucy's Little Forest School brings stories to life at Wilderness Woods. With Secret Paths, fairy circles, deep dark woods, old gnarled trees, there's everything you need to stimulate the imagination. We provide a rich environment roofed only by sky (and a few gems from our own store cupboard)

The children find the secret path....to do this they need to walk by the log piles, over a bridge, past the green man and then look for the secret path sign hidden in the wood! Once they have found the secret path they must STOP..... They will need a woodland ticket to enter!!!!



Once we have entered, we discover the story telling circle. We will read a story and the adventure begins. With any of the activities listed below we will have the opportunity to walk the secret path, collect natural materials for the activity and enjoy spotting what nature has to offer. We have a big bad wolf sign, fairy and elf circle, giants chair, a hedgehogs home and lots more to explore on the way. Set the scene for other activities, we can leave extra materials can be left in the wood....red riding hoods basket, bear bowls of empty porridge! Robin hoods hat, bow and arrow. All of these activities are hands – on and its about letting your imagination go wild and free both children and adults!
